- **One PGY1 Position**
 - Program Start Date: June
- **Specific Expectations**
 - Florida pharmacist license by Oct 1st
- **Twelve months of rotations**
- **Pharmacy practice experiences/ staffing**
 - Every 3rd weekend, starting in Aug
 - Expect 1 shift/partial shift per week
 - Mostly evening coverage

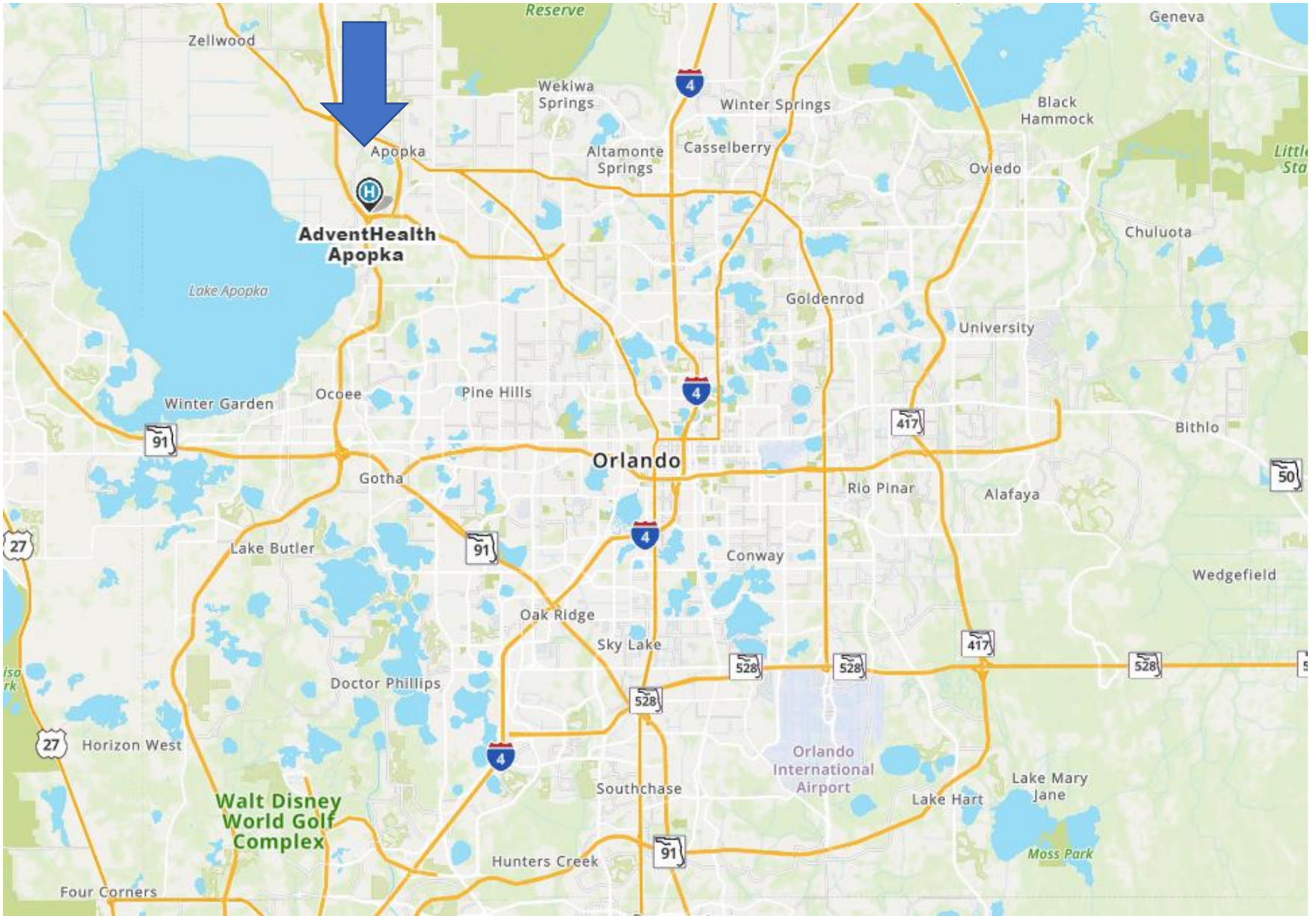
